Permission for Pool and Beach Activities: Every camper will go swimming in the camp's pool each day, weather permitting. Three-year-olds have water play in the 1-foot section of the pool; Red Cross group swimming lessons begin at age four. (Three-year-olds may sign up for private lessons). When the children are swimming, there is at least one certified lifeguard and a counselor present. We have an accident-free record. The water in the pool is tested four times a day and a sample is sent monthly for testing. We take every precaution to insure the children's health and safety.

Upper campers go on field trips that may include swimming. Kindergarteners go on one field trip per summer. At least two counselors are present at each elective site. All staff members (counselors and aides) are first aid and CPR certified.
