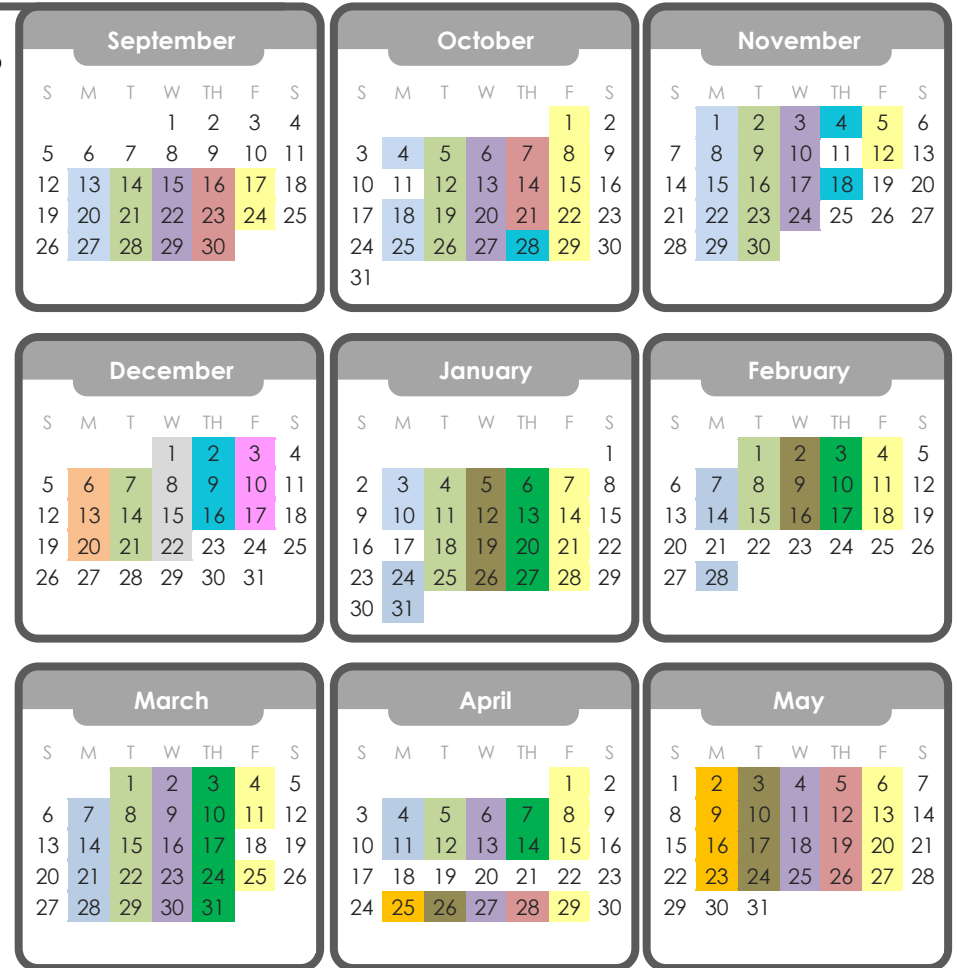

Let's Act It Out

Students participate in the many facets of drama: dramatic play, skits, creating masks and costumes, designing props and scenery, and practicing writing their own productions.

"A" is for Art

Students will create and learn the many areas of art: learning various artists and replicating their art work through their eyes, making seasonal and holiday gifts and experimenting with different mediums.

Our Big Backyard

Students investigate the world around them: nature crafts, various world projects and science experiments.

Horticulture & Gardening

Students learn about horticulture and gardening in many ways: to plant, care for yards and gardens, using our greenhouse and growing things.

Creative Movement

Students will use their bodies to stretch, twist and dance in many creative and different ways: yoga, creative movement, dancing, etc. They will also play group games learning cooperation and good sportsmanship.

Elementary Afterschool Club Descriptions

Poekoelan Club (Class maximum 8, minimum 3) – Grades 1 through 5

The class is an introduction to the Indonesian Martial Art called Poekoelan Tjimindie Tulen. Children will be introduced to the basics of self defense, how to kick properly, and how to move like the different animals used in this martial art. Head instructor: Karin Pearce-Small, second-degree black belt with 8 years of instruction; Ali Crocket: brown sash with 5 years of instruction.

Scrapbooking Club

Students will create their own scrapbooks. Please bring 5-10 pictures that can be cut for their album.

Sleuth Club

This "mystery" club includes puzzles, scavenger hunts, sleuth games, and more. Children will "tease" their brains with this!

Newspaper Club – Grades 1 through 5

Students share their creativity and thoughts with you and their fellow students while learning how to write and run a real school newspaper. The papers are published in the school year and distribute to families, friends and the community.

Arts & Crafts Club

Students build art-related skills through a variety of creative crafts projects to develop self-expression and individual creativity and self-discovery.

Basketball Club – Grades 1 through 5

Students will learn the fundamentals of basketball, team-work and the game. Open to boys and girls, the more students the better!

Pinewood Derby Club (Class maximum 10, minimum 4)

Students create and race their own wood-made cars; research and implement strategies to propel their cars; and culminate with a race on the last week.

Soccer PTU Club

This club is run by PTUSA professional coaches and is designed to challenge every type of player, while building self-esteem and confidence with the ball.

Creative Movement Club

Students will learn many different forms of exercise, dance and yoga. More information coming soon.

Cheerleading Club
