FundingFactory provides a FREE, simple program to help schools like The Laurel School earn funds while recycling to help improve the environment. By simply collecting and recycling inkjet and laser cartridges, and/or your old cell phones/blackberry's we can earn FREE technology, sports and recreation equipment, playground systems, or cash.

How it works:

Simply drop off your empty (or full unused) inkjet and laser cartridges, and your old cell phones/blackberry's to The Laurel School and we'll do the rest (our FundingFactory recycle bin is located in the recycle center in the big room).

1 point = \$.40

For every cartridge, cell phone and blackberry that qualifies we earn points. To see which ones qualify for points go to: www.fundingfactory.com

If you have empty cartridges or cell phones that are not on the qualifying point list, don't worry – drop them off too. As a school that cares about the environment, recycling is very important to us!

- ✓ One-half gallon of oil is conserved for every laser cartridge that is recycled. With the U.S. consuming nearly 700 million gallons of oil per day, we need to help conserve this valuable, non-renewable resource.

Cartridges and phones are inspected by FundingFactory and then supplied to companies who will remanufacture or refurbish them. Over 90% of units received are able to be recycled. The other 10% can be recycled for their component parts.
